NARRATIVE REGARDING PRIMARY PROGRAMS AND PURPOSES

The titles of these programs are to coincide with the schedule of financial information for each that is attached.

FAITH AND FREEDOM TOURS – Tours are facilitated to visit and study the history of various locations important to American history and heritage. These tours last between 1 and 2 weeks and each are attended by 100-200 people. A non-deductible fee is charged to the participants to help defray costs.

FATHER AND SON RETREAT – These retreats are typically a weekend in length and attended by 400-500 participants. The focus of these retreats is to increase the family bond between generations, specifically between fathers and sons. A non-deductible fee is charged to participants to help defray costs.

CREATION TOURS – These are extended trips attended by 30-40 participants. These tours visit sites that important to the scientific discussion regarding creation and evolution. A non-deductible fee is charged to participants to help defray costs.

CHRISTIAN FILM FESTIVAL – This is a major event in San Antonio each year. It offers an academy on the process of film making which is attended by approximately 400 participants, and it also has a film festival which is attended by approximately 2,000 participants. Various prizes are awarded to film makers in various categories. The film festival is specifically oriented to Christian themed movies. Various fees are charged to defray costs.

FAITH OF OUR FATHERS – This program is specific to honoring war veterans, specifically WWII veterans. Educational tours are facilitated to key locations specific to WWII. Non-deductible fees are charged to participants to defray costs.

FATHER AND DAUGHTER RETREATS – Similar to the Father and Son Retreats, these retreats are typically for a weekend and are attended by 400-500 participants. The focus is increasing the family bond, specifically between father and daughter. A non-deductible fee is charged to participants to help defray costs.

200 YEAR PLAN – This is a small program given less frequently which promotes techniques to create a family life vision to promote the quality of family life.

J PARK PROGRAM – This is a radio broadcast, now on approximately 400 hundred radio stations in the U.S. which promotes the study of science from a Christian perspective. Various products are sold through this program promoting the same.

BABY CONFERENCE – This is a conference attended by approximately 2,000 participants that studies, in depth, medical and ethical issues regarding the value of life in infant stages.

ROYALTIES RECEIVED – Products that have been developed to promote to the core messages of the entity have been developed by the organization and sold through licensing agreements with various retailers and wholesalers.
